You will not be able to use Public Transportation or Med Ride to transport you home after your procedure.

If you have had an upper GI x-ray and the doctor has not seen it, please bring it with you. Shopping List (no prescription needed):

- Four (4) Senekot tablets
- Two (2) enemas

Preparation

The afternoon before your procedure you should have a clear liquid supper. Take the four (4) Senekot tablets at bedtime the night before your procedure.

If your procedure is scheduled before noon, DO NOT eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your procedure except a small amount of water to take your regular medications. If your test is scheduled after noon, you may have clear liquids until 7:00am the day of your procedure. After 7:00am, you should not have anything to drink except a small amount of water to take your regular medications.

One hour before leaving home, take two enemas rectally according to the following instructions: Take one enema, hold it for three to five minutes, and then expel the fluid; immediate take the second enema by the same instructions.
